On the Canal des Vosges, visitors will find the pleasure boat harbour and its recently created marina, offering impressive, modern infrastructure leading onto the Saône, with a 180 sq. m harbour master's office ideally equipped for boaters and 70 moorings for boats of up to 20 m in length.

A CHARMING STOP-OFF AT CHEMILLY



Here, the Durgeon and the Saône intersect at the foot of a medieval castle. A fairytale setting which can be reached via a long metal footbridge, linking the lock and the wharf to the village. A village which has quite a surprise up its sleeve: on an old stone bridge you'll find a mysterious statue, that of Saint John of Nepomuk, confessor to the Queen of Bohemia in the 15th century.
